RULES & REGULATIONS - ALL STUD CATTLE

1. Stud cattle exhibits from herds Classified as tested negative (TN) or confirmed free with respect Brucellosis.
2. Please note that a J-BAS of 6 is required to nominate for the Stud Cattle Competition
3. All Cattle to be NLIS Tagged and have appropriate travel permit.
4. Exhibitor to supply the Chief Steward with a photocopy of their travel permit
5. When exhibited at shows all bulls over 12 months must have nose ring or nose-grip, females 9 months and above must have nose ring or nose-grip.
6. The age of all cattle must be actual age as at 1st April 2021.
7. All animals entered MUST be registered in a herd or calf register of the respective Breed Society and MUST be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.
8. All animals MUST have a brand, either tattoo or fire. The brand MUST be stated on the entry form.
9. All animals, which in the opinion of the stewards, are not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected by them and debarred from competition. Such animals must be removed from the grounds as soon as exhibitor is notified.
10. In the event of the Judge deciding that the exhibit in any Class or Championship is not worthy of the prize, no prize shall be awarded.
11. For Senior Championship Prize, all First Prize winners of the sex and breed are eligible to compete. After selecting the CHAMPION, the Judge is required to select an animal for the Reserve CHAMPION, which will take the place of the CHAMPION in the event of his being disqualified for any cause. The Reserve CHAMPION shall be selected from the remaining First Prize winners, together with the Second Prize winner of the Class which furnished the CHAMPION.
12. Dehorned cattle may compete in Stud Section if conditions are acceptable to their respective Breed Society.
13. The Wandoan Show Grounds is Tick Protected. Stud Cattle originating from a tick area PLEASE REFER TO DAF REGULATIONS LISTED IN THIS SCHEDULE
14. Any unwanted ribbons may be returned to the Steward.
15. Wandoan Show Society reserves the right to change or modify any of the Schedule, at any time and at our sole discretion.

WANDOAN SHOW GROUNDS TICK STATUS:

**** DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE & FISHERIES ****

The Wandoan Memorial Grounds are situated within the Cattle Tick FREE Area.
All livestock entering these grounds are required to be free of cattle ticks and to have met the movement conditions of the Stock Act 1915 and Stock Regulations 1990.

The following conditions apply to the movement of stock from tick-infected areas to the Memorial Grounds.

A. HORSES REQUIRE ONE CLEAN SUPERVISED TREATMENT

B. CATTLE- refer to DAF cattle tick movement regulations. In certain cases, a pre-treatment declaration must accompany stock from infected areas when presented for clean inspection and treatment at a clearing facility.

1. **Stud Cattle** - Led Tractable and Groomed.

ONE SUPERVISED CLEAN TREATMENT

Movement to commence within 24 hours of the second treatment.

Spraying is acceptable for treatments. **Refer Movement Regulations**

SECTION 4 - YOUNG PARADERS COMPETITION

Beef Cattle and Dairy Cattle Paraders Competition Rules:

To be eligible for the State Finals competitors must comply with all of these Rules. These competitions are designed to determine the Parader who presents and parades an animal before a Judge most effectively. Paraders will parade their animals in a clockwise manner as is normal in a Cattle Judging Ring at the discretion of the Judge.

(1) Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on the 1st May in the year of the State Final.

(2) Competitors under 18 years of age must have the approval of a parent or guardian to compete.

(3) Competitors are to be resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to competing or attending an educational institution in Queensland unless they qualify under Rule (4)

(4) Competitors residing over the border who can prove an affinity with a Queensland Show are allowed entry provided they satisfy one of the following criteria:

- a. Their address has a Queensland postcode
- b. They have a Queensland phone number
- c. The competitor or their parents are active working members of that Show.

(5) National winners are ineligible to compete

PROCEDURE

1. One Class of Paraders is to be judged.
2. Beef Cattle Paraders may lead a Steer, Heifer or Bull under 20 months.
3. Dairy Cattle Paraders may lead a Dairy Female under 36 months (DRY)
4. Paraders must wear a white coat and not display any name or logo.
5. Paraders must be willing to swap animals if required.
6. Prior to commencement of Judging, Stewards are to consult with the Owners of Beasts to ascertain if their animals can be switched between handlers.
7. Stewards are to advise Judges that switching of animals is only to be considered if agreed by Owners and where absolutely necessary to achieve a result.
8. 8. stud cattle area towards the completion of the stud cattle judging.
9. Emphasis will be placed on the child not the quality of the beast.
10. If nominations allow, Classes will be further subdivided.

The Hormel Slide must be used at all levels in the Young Judges Competitions.

To be eligible for the State Finals, competitors must comply with all of these Rules.

There are five categories in the YOUNG JUDGES COMPETITION:

1. MERINO SHEEP
2. MEAT SHEEP
3. STUD BEEF CATTLE
4. DAIRY CATTLE
5. PRIME CATTLE

Local Show Rules

1. No minimum age for Local Competitors
2. Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on the 1st May in the year of the State Final, to compete at sub-chamber level
3. Competitors under 18 years of age must have the approval of a parent or guardian to compete.
4. Competitors are to be resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to competing or attending an Educational institution in Queensland unless they qualify under Rule (4).
5. Competitors residing over the border who can prove an affinity with a Queensland show are allowed entry provided they satisfy one of the following criteria-
 - (a) Their address has a Queensland postcode.
 - (b) They have a Queensland phone number.
 - (c) The competitor or their parents are active working members of that Show.
6. National winners or persons on a National judging panel for that event are ineligible to compete.

Sub Chamber Rules

Rules (2-6) in the local Show Rules apply to all Sub-Chamber Finals.

7. Sub-Chamber will decide the number of competitors from each Show who will compete at their Final.
8. Competitors can represent only one Show in the Sub-Chamber final.
9. A State Final Entry Form must be completed by the winner of each Competition immediately after judging and forwarded to the QCAS State Office by the Sub-Chamber Secretary/Co-ordinator.

State Final Rules

Rules (2-6) in the local Show rules apply to all State Finals.

10. Sub-Chambers are to be represented by the Sub-Chamber winner. If he/she is unable to compete the next highest places contestant is eligible.
11. Competitors can represent only one Sub-Chamber in the State final

12. The winner of the RNA competitions will be invited to compete in the State Final provided they are eligible under local Show rules (2–6).

In all competitions four exhibits numbered 1, 2, 3 and 4 are to be used. (To suit the scoring from the Hormel Slide).

If possible, all competitions should have the following Classes:-

Stud Cattle 3 Classes to be used eg. (British, Tropical, European)

Prime Cattle 2 Classes to be used eg. (Jap Ox, Korean, Local Trade etc.)
